- 7. **Promote Inclusivity:** To promote a more inclusive and equitable environment by ensuring that gender equality is embedded in institutional policies, practices, and culture.





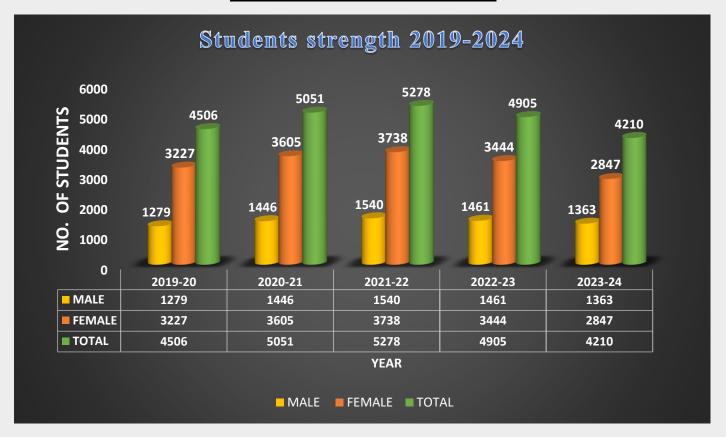

- Despite fluctuations in total enrolment, female students consistently represent a larger portion of the student body compared to male students.



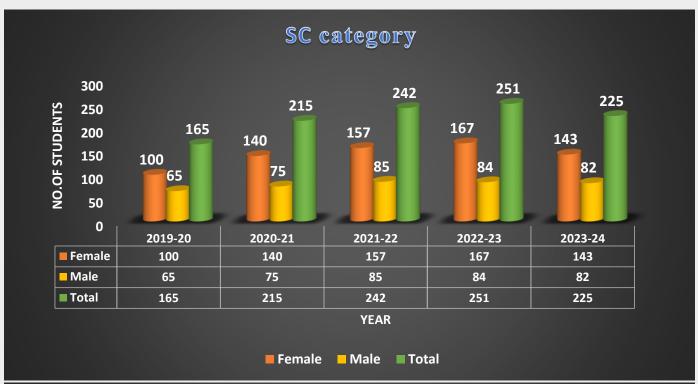


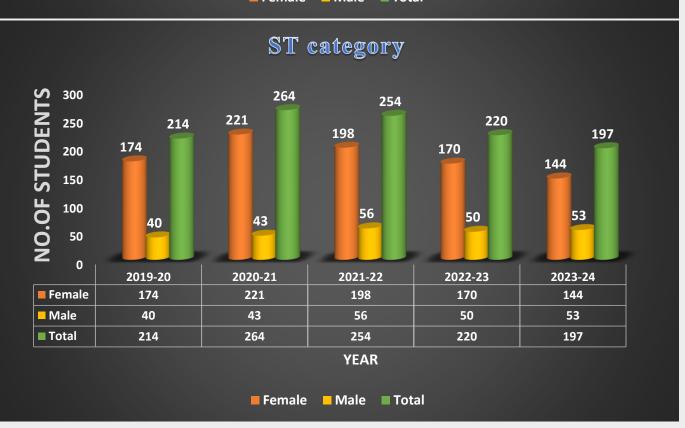

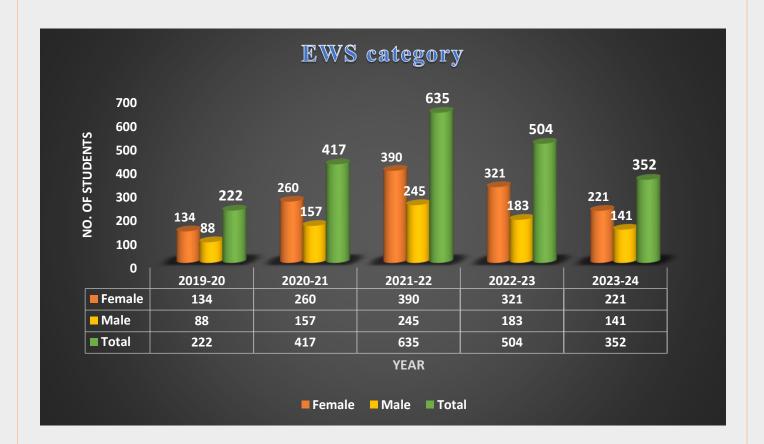

Note- There is no Gender Audit of PG as PG is only for Girls in our college.





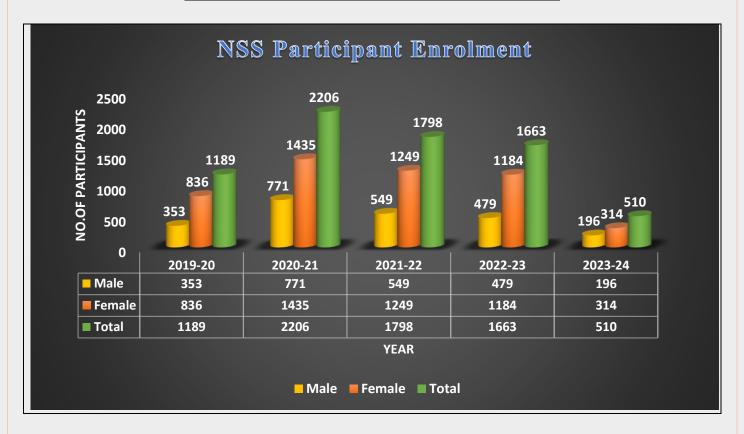

Note- There is no Gender Audit of NCC as NCC is only for Girls in our college.





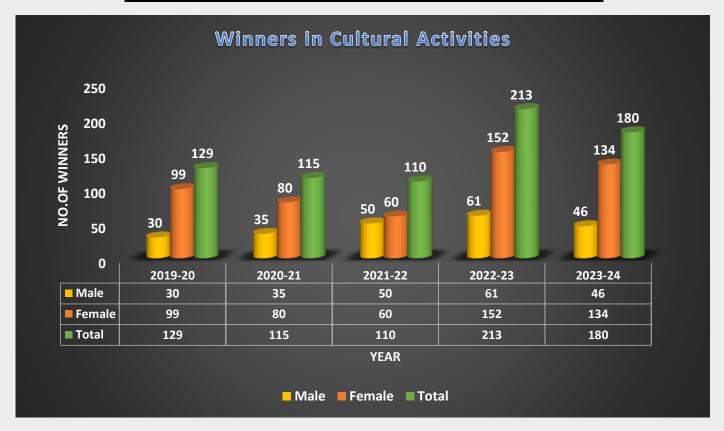

The focus is on the overall gender distribution and the presence of female chairpersons. Increase in Total Chairpersons: The total number of chairpersons increased from 31 in 2019-2020 to 64 in 2023-2024. Growth in Female Chairpersons: The number of female chairpersons increased from 14 in 2019-2020 to 20 in 2023-2024. Despite an overall increase in the number of chairpersons, the percentage of female chairpersons has decreased slightly over the years, from 45.2% in 2019-2020 to 31.3% in 2023-2024. # **PROGRESSION OF STUDENTS**

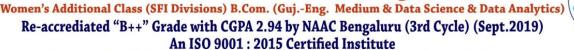

Our teaching and non-teaching staff include accomplished female professionals, and we proudly have a female chairperson leading several of our committees. This representation underscores our commitment to gender equality and the valuable contributions of women in all areas of our institution."

To address the disparity in sports achievements between male and female athletes, it is essential to implement targeted initiatives that enhance support, provide additional resources, and create more opportunities for female athletes. This focused effort will help bridge the gap and enable female students to achieve greater success in sports."
